Emergency Information Related to Hurricane Sandy

Updated Sunday 10/28/12

The Governor has issued a State of Emergency and High Wind and Flood watches have been issued at this time. Winds are expected to be 50 – 70 mph with 80 mph gusts on Monday afternoon into Tuesday afternoon.

Residents are urged to take all necessary precautions for your safety, securing all outdoor property and preparing for loss of power.

Alternate Parking Arrangements

If you live in a flood prone area, you should move your vehicles to higher grounds. You have permission to use the parking lot at OLPH and at Shop Rite in the upper parking lot dirt area. Please leave contact information on your dash board.

Garbage and Recycling

There will be garbage pick-up and yard waste pick up on Monday, October 29th. However yard waste pick up is cancelled for Tuesday, October 30th. Further updates will be provided regarding the Recycling pick up scheduled for Wednesday, October 31st.
